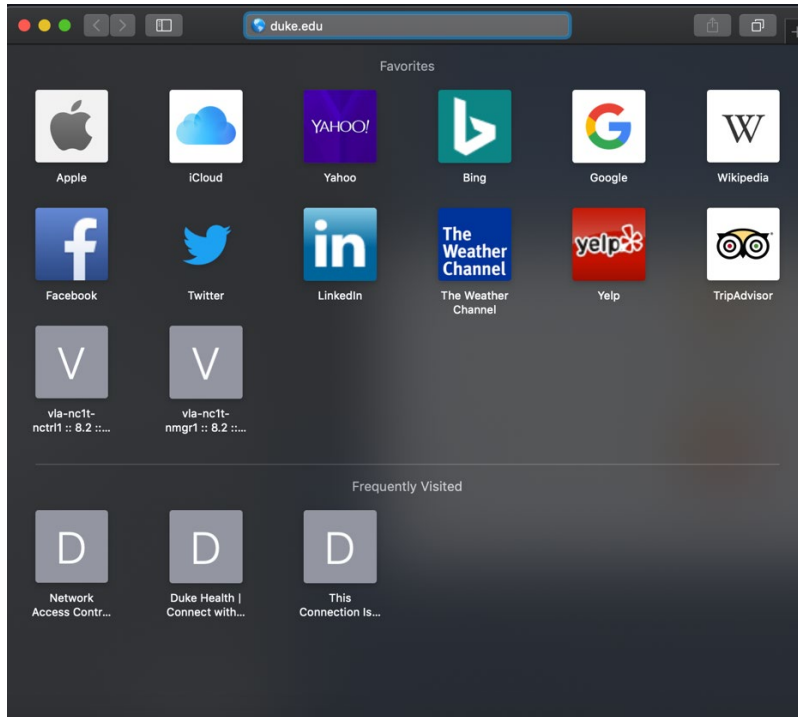
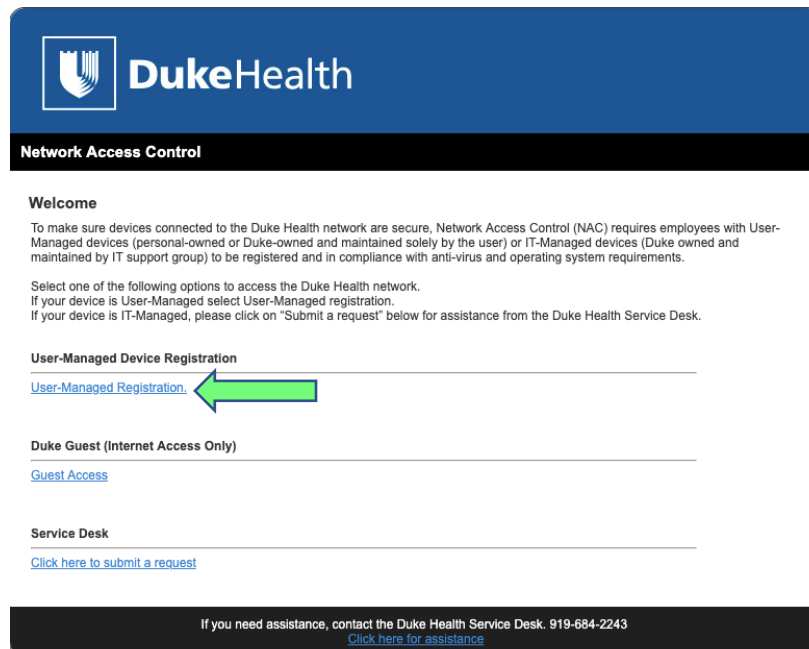


User-Managed Device Post-NAC Enforcement Registration Process


1. Open a Web Browser, Type “duke.edu” and hit enter



2. The NAC registration Portal page will appear. Click on “User Managed Registration”



3. Type in your Duke NetID and Password, then click “Continue”

Each user is required to verify that their PC will meet established network policies prior to connecting to the network.



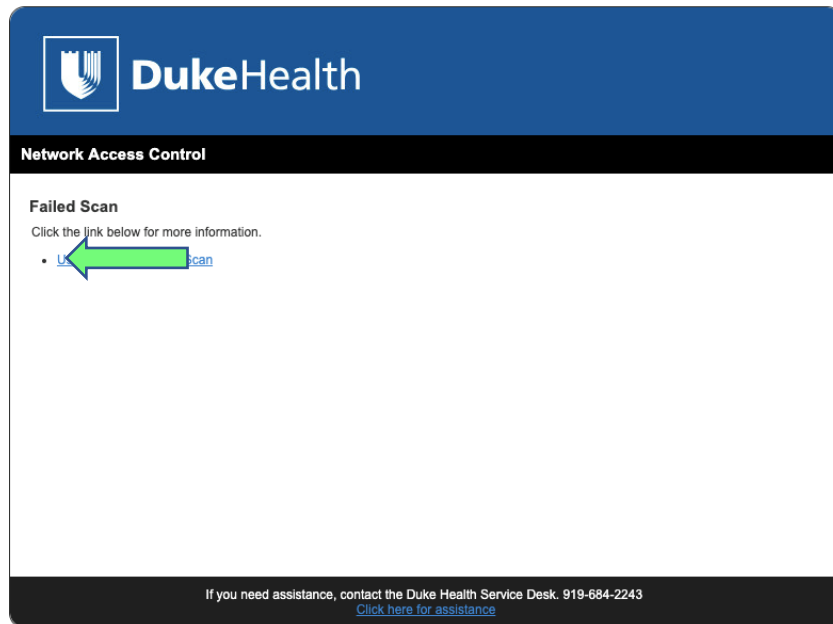

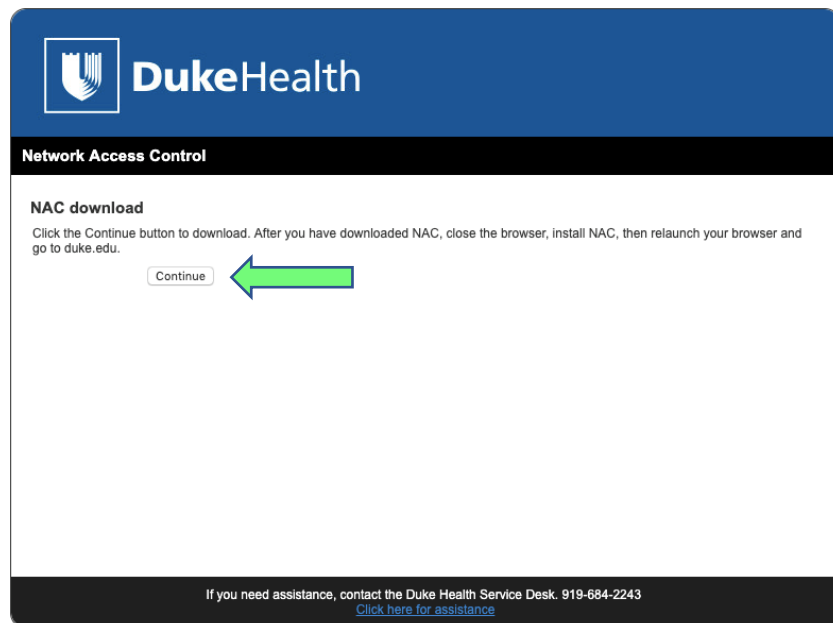

5. Click “User Managed Wired Scan”

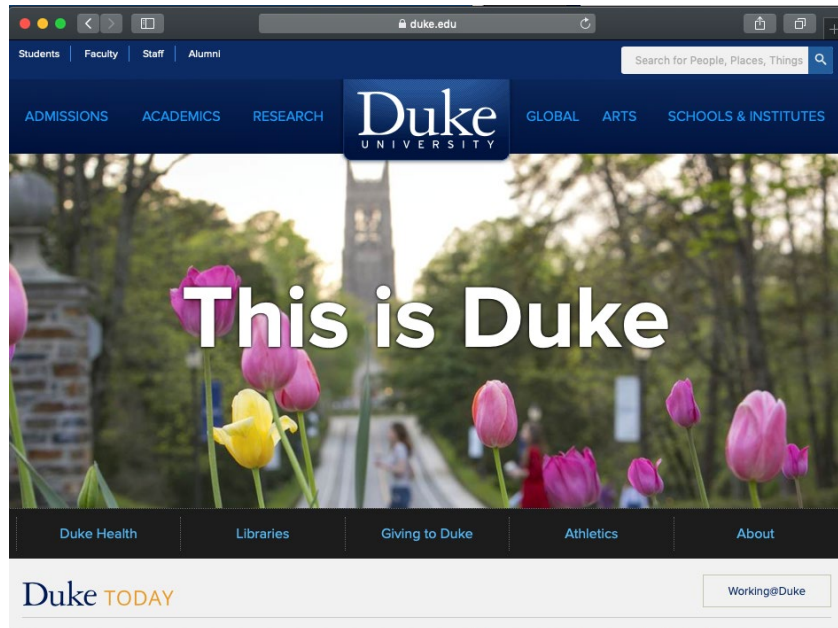


6. Click “Continue” to download NAC

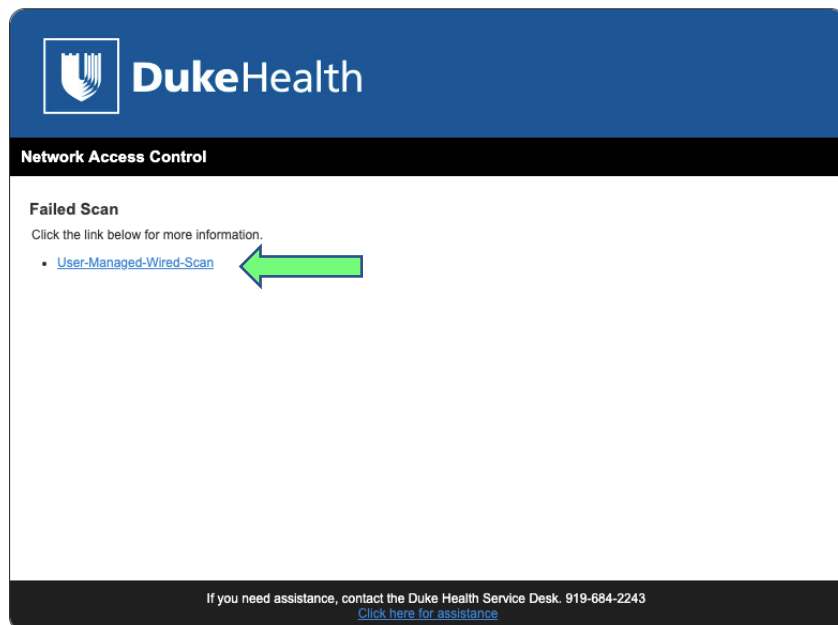


7. Close your browser and install the NAC Agent
8. Relaunch your browser and Type “duke.edu” and hit enter

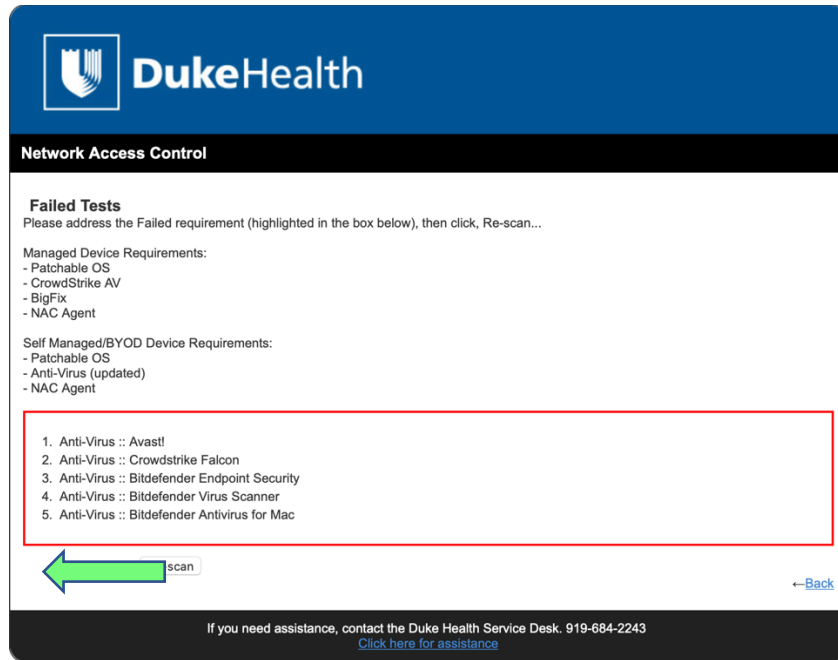
9. If your device passes the User-Managed device requirements, you will connect to Duke’s website and no further action is needed.



10. If your device fails the User Managed device requirements, click the “*User Managed Wired Scan*” link to review what failed.



11. The example below displays that an Anti-Virus is installed. Download and install an approved Anti-Virus, then click “Re-scan”.
